Setting up of the Commission for travel grants for participants coming from Latin America / Europe / Spain. Resolution and awarding for the course "Migrations and Refugees: Cities Experience in Europe"

Minutes of the setting-up of the Barcelona'gov Commission for evaluating the grant applications for participants coming from Latin America, Europe and Spain

In Barcelona, October 31, 2017, the meeting of the Coordination Committe of the network Barcelona'gov AGREES:

Setting-up the Barcelona'gov Commission and Selection formed by the members of the Coordinator Committee Joan Subirats Humet, Jacint Jordana Casajuana, Miquel Salvador Serna and Juan Carlos Triviño. They evaluated the applications for participants coming from Latin America, Europe and Spain for attending the course "Migrations and Refugees: Cities Experience in Europe", taking place in November 21-24, and according to the rules and conditions established for this course at http://barcelonagov.net.

Resolution of the grant for the course "Migrations and Refugees: Cities Experience in Europe"


The Selection Commission evaluates the applications including the CV and the motivation letter of each candidate, and analyzing the background and profiles of each one of them to the contents of the course. The Selection Committee determines:

- 1) Admit and approve the grant applications listed in ANNEX 1 of this resolution, for an individual amount <u>up to 850 euros</u> (for Latin American candidates), <u>up to 400 euros</u> (for European candidates), and <u>up to 200 euros</u> (for Spanish candidates) to cover travel expenses exclusively, in the terms established in the course information.
- 2) To inform through the same resolution that:
 - a) For the <u>definitive granting of these scholarships</u>, each candidate must confirm their acceptance within a period of five days from the moment in which the resolution is notified to him/her. If, on that date, the admitted and approved candidate did not confirm the acceptance, it will be understood that the grant is waived and may be assigned to another candidate or reserve candidate (see ANNEX 1).
 - b) Each candidate <u>must formalize the registration and make the payment of the registration</u> established for the Course "Migrations and Refugees: Cities Experience in Europe" <u>before Friday</u>, <u>November 17</u>, <u>2017</u>. In the event that on that date the candidate admitted and approved had not made the registration and payment of the

enrollment will be deemed to waive the grant and this may be assigned to another candidate or candidate enrolled in the course, and cannot opt for the refund of the ticket.

- c) In order to facilitate and expedite the payment of the scholarship to the candidates who have been awarded the grant, they must <u>submit</u>, at the <u>beginning of the course</u> in <u>Barcelona</u>, the invoice and the <u>original travel cost ticket along with a photocopy of their passport</u>, against which <u>they will receive a check</u> with the amount granted up to 850 euros (for Latin American candidates), up to 400 euros (for European candidates), and up to 200 euros (for Spanish candidates), and must sign an "as received".
- d) Accommodation and breakfast of the candidates who have been awarded the grant will be directly covered by Barcelona. Gov, who will provide them with the hotel establishment when the award of the grant is communicated.
