RESEARCH INTERESTS

Changing marriage and partnership behaviour

The basic changes in marriage and partnership are the related processes of gradual retreat from marriage; expansion of non marital cohabitation; long-lasting postponement of marriage and union formation; rising divorce rates; progressive legalisation of same-sex partnerships; remarriage and stepfamily formation. For the Spanish case, I have already examined the dynamics of non marital cohabitation and the characteristics of the same-sex couples. My specific purpose is to assess the fertility outcomes of this new partnership forms and trajectories.

Impact of international migration on family dynamics

Research has shown the impact of the increase of international migration flows on marriage market through the dynamics of intermarriage between migrants and natives. In my doctoral and postdoctoral research, I have specifically highlighted the impact of the arrival of international migration on the dynamics of partnership in Spain. My purpose is to further develop the implications of the interaction between migrants and natives in terms of childbearing patterns.

Gender relations within partnerships and families

Female instruction and employment, together with work-family balance, are key aspects to the analysis of changing families and partnerships in contemporary Europe. I have assessed the impact of the educational expansion and of the postponement of marriage on Spanish patterns of spouse selection.
