Digital Communications Officer

This EU Research and Education Network on Foreign Policy Issues, focused on Values and Democracy, unites 21 distinguished higher education institutions from Europe and beyond to enhance debate and expand knowledge of the EU's foreign policy concerning values and democracy.

The role includes:

- A university degree in International Relations or Political Science, with knowledge of the EU's external policy considered beneficial.
- Fluency in English, with a minimum of level C1 in the Common European Framework of Reference (CEFR).
- Experience in the production and development of podcasts, webinars, and blogs.
- A solid understanding of social media and web tools.
- Video production experience would be advantageous.
