

## TUITION FEES

### Master's Programmes. Academic year 2023 – 2024

#### 1. Course fees:

- Master's in International Relations, Master's in International Security, Master's in International Development, and Master's in Public Policy: €200 per credit. Full-time (60 credits in 1 year) or part-time (60 credits in 2 years) options available. The credit price for second-year students in the part-time mode remains at €190.
- Research Master's in International Studies. €200 per credit.
  - **New incoming students** enrolling in the **complete two-year programme** (120 ECTS) will receive a 25% discount for the second year of their studies, up to a maximum of 60 credits.
  - **IBEI Alumni** enrolling in the second year of the Master's in Research in International Studies will pay €120 per ECTS for all required credits.
  - **New incoming students who have already successfully completed a master's degree at another university** and can, therefore, apply for the recognition of some credits completed during this first master's programme. The price per credit for credits not recognized and counted toward the first year of the Master's in Research in International Studies is €200. During their second year of studies, students benefit from a 25% discount for up to 60 ECTS. In this case, the credit price remains at €190.
  - **Credit recognition:**
    - €9.88 per recognized credit (regulated by Decree 128/2022 of June 28, published in DOGC No. 8699, dated June 30). Prices will be updated in June 2023 according to the new decree.
    - €54.54 for the study of the academic record for credit recognition (regulated by Decree 128/2022 of June 28, published in DOGC No. 8699, dated June 30). Prices will be updated in June 2023 according to the new decree.
    - IBEI Alumni are exempt from the above two fees.
- Erasmus Mundus Masters Program in Public Policy (Mundus MAPP): €11,000 up to 62 credits. Additional credits: €200.

*Reduced fees may apply as set by specific grant calls launched or promoted by IBEI after free public competition.*

#### 2. Application Processing

- Full application processing fee: €30

#### 3. Price per credit (second-time registration, visiting students, enrolment extension) and for the Internship and Exchange Programmes (to guarantee the student's connection with the IBEI and its follow-up):

##### A. Price per credit

- Price per credit: €200
- Price per credit for extended registration, former students, and second enrolment: €120
- Price per credit for retaking courses or second and subsequent attempts: €200.

##### B. Exchange Programme

- Final Research Project extension to March 2025: €75 (all students participating in an exchange programme must request an extension of the Final Research Project to March 2025).



### C. Internship Programme

- Price for curricular internships:
  - Enrolment of 4 credits corresponding to the internship: €60
  - Final Research Project extension to March 2025: €75
- Price for non-curricular internships: €60

### D. Final Research Project Extension

- Final Research Project extension to March 2025 (if students request it within the Final Research Project tutor allocation deadline): €75
- Final Research Project extension to September 2025 (if students request it within the Final Research Project tutor allocation deadline): €300
- Extension of the TFM to March 2025 (if the students request it after the Final Research Project tutor allocation deadline): €150.
- Final Research Project extension to September 2025 (if the students request it after the Final Research Project tutor allocation deadline or fail or do not submit the Final Research Project within the ordinary call): €800

## Additional academic services

### 1. Fees for additional academic certificates:

- Price per certificate: €27.27 (regulated by Decree 128/2022 of June 28, published in DOGC No. 8699, dated June 30). Prices will be updated in June 2023 in accordance with the new decree.
- Price for each additional copy: €2

### 2. Issuing and validation of academic qualifications and diplomas:

- Fees for the issuance of official degrees: €218.15 (regulated by Decree 128/2022 of June 28, published in DOGC No. 8699, dated June 30). Prices will be updated in June 2023 in accordance with the new decree.
- Recognition of credits from university-specific degrees in order to access an official degree: €200.
- Fees for the issuance of documents recognising foreign degrees: €50 (equivalence assessment).

## Summer School 2023

### 1. Registration Fees:

- Course fee (10 hours):
  - Face-to-face: €400 (Students: €250)
  - Online: €160 (Students: €100)
- Course fee (4 hours):
  - Face-to-face: €170 (Students: €110)
  - Online: €100 (Students: €45)
- Early bird fee (payment at least 1 month in advance): 10%
- Discount for enrolment in two courses (20%), three courses (30%), 4 courses (40%)
