SUMMER SCHOOL

The **IBEI Summer School in Global Politics, Development and Security** is a program designed for graduate students and all those who have an interest in advanced knowledge of international security, international development and global politics issues. The objective is to offer **different short courses on significant topics**, taught by scholars and experts of international prestige. The School will enable participants to broadly discuss current developments in world politics in the light of core social-science and IR theories and perspectives. Optionally, **students may ask for an assessment in order to be able to obtain ECTS credits**, provided they are recognized by their university.

The format will be face to face. Some courses will be offered in hybrid format (classes will run simultaneously face to face and online).

SCHOLARSHIPS

To apply for a scholarship, interested persons must send to IBEI (Carlos Sánchez, csanchez@ibei.org) **until 20th May 2022**, a letter of interest, a CV, and a recommendation letter. **Scholarship will be communicated before 30th May 2022.**

CERTIFICATE

At the conclusion of the Summer School, **participants will receive a certificate for the number of hours attended.** All IBEI courses require an average of twice the lecture hours for readings, pre-readings and class preparation. Upon previous request, IBEI faculty can provide an assessment of the courses, and the grade obtained can be included into the certificate, in case students aim to transfer them into ECTS credits:

- ▶ **10 hour course:** 2 ECTS credits
- ▶ **6 hour course:** 1 ECTS credit

Minimum required: 3 ECTS credits.

ADMISSION PROCESS
