#### **SUMMER SCHOOL**

The IBEI Summer School in Global Politics, Development and Security is a program designed for graduate students and all those who have an interest in advanced knowledge of international security, international development and global politics issues. The objective is to offer different short courses on significant topics, taught by scholars and experts of international prestige. The School will enable participants to broadly discuss current developments in world politics in the light of core social-science and IR theories and perspectives. Optionally, students may ask for an assessment in order to be able to obtain ECTS credits, provided they are recognized by their university.

The format will be online and hybrid (classes will run simultaneously face to face and online to allow students to choose the modality that best suits their needs). Some courses will only be offered online.

#### **SCHOLARSHIPS**

A number of scholarships to cover full or half course fees will be available.

To apply for a scholarship, interested persons must send to IBEI (Carlos Sánchez, <a href="mailto:csanchez@ibei.org">csanchez@ibei.org</a>) until 20th May 2021, a letter of interest, a CV, and a recommendation letter. Scholarship will be communicated before 30th May 2021.

#### **CERTIFICATE**

At the conclusion of the Summer School, participants will receive a certificate for the number of hours attended. All IBEI courses require an average of twice the lecture hours for readings, pre-readings and class preparation. Upon previous request, IBEI faculty can provide an assessment of the courses, and the grade obtained can be included into the certificate, in case students aim to transfer them into ECTS credits:

▶ 10 hour course: 2 ECTS credits▶ 6 hour course: 1 ECTS credit

Minimum required: 3 ECTS credits

#### **ADMISSION PROCESS**
